- HB 2881 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services for Oregon Hunger Response Fund program services.
- HB 3398 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services to fund Hunger Task Force.
- HB 2534 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Community Leverage Fund.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3160
Permits persons who have limited vision to carry and use white canes on highways and other public places.
- HB 2930
Requires Department of Human Services and law enforcement agency to make efforts to determine military status of parents or guardians of child who is subject of report of child abuse.

Work Session

- HB 2011
Directs Housing and Community Services Department to administer study to assess disparities between federal and local calculations of fair market rent.
- HB 2315 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Provides that corporate excise tax credit allowed to lenders that finance affordable housing is not barred by receipt of housing vouchers by tenants.

March 28, 2017

- HB 2685
Requires Department of Human Services or designee of department to offer adult with intellectual or developmental disability who qualifies for comprehensive services at least one placement other than congregate living arrangement.
- HB 2401
Requires Department of Human Services and Department of Justice to provide trauma-informed training and curriculum to child welfare personnel.
- HB 2919
Requires certain facilities providing residential accommodations for persons 55 years of age or older to notify Oregon Health Authority prior to providing food services for residents.
- HB 2959 **
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services to administer general assistance project. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
