Work Session

- HB 2210 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/4 AGENDA Directs Housing and Community Services Department to develop and implement Retaining Affordable Rental Housing Program to provide grants to owners of multifamily rental housing to rehabilitate and maintain housing at affordable rental rates.
- HB 2221
Requires Oregon Health Authority and Department of Consumer and Business Services to report to Legislative Assembly each calendar quarter on implementation of requirements to reimburse cost of child abuse medical assessments conducted by community assessment centers.
- HB 2500 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services to develop and implement training and continuing education curriculum for department caseworkers that informs and instructs caseworkers on their roles in juvenile dependency proceedings.
- HB 2170 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Office of Oregon Ombudsmen, containing Long Term Care Ombudsman, Residential Facilities Ombudsman, Foster Parent Ombudsman, Foster Child Ombudsman and Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator.

- HB 2741 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates money from General Fund for deposit into Wildfire Damage Housing Relief Account.
- HB 2742 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Increases household income limitation for receipt of financial assistance from Wildfire Damage Housing Relief Account.
- HB 3063 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Mental Health Housing Fund, appropriates moneys to Oregon Health Authority and requires authority to seek out and apply for additional moneys for fund to pay for construction and start-up costs of housing for individuals with mental illness.

HB 3273

Modifies requirements relating to evacuation of residents of adult foster homes.

HB 3359

Creates Dementia Community Assistance Program in Department of Human Services to provide grants to community organizations providing assistance and training to individuals who care for persons with dementia who live at home.

Modifies definition of "abuse" occurring in child-caring agencies.
