Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3405 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Requires Department of Human Services to seek waiver of federal requirements in Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program in order to allow recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance to receive advance installment payments of tax credit for dependent care expenses.
- HB 3373 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to Housing and Community Services Department and Department of Land Conservation and Development to employ two full-time equivalent employees to perform services relating to increasing availability of affordable housing.
- HB 2377 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Authorizes city or county to adopt ordinance or resolution granting exemption for newly rehabilitated or constructed multiunit rental housing.
- HB 3155
Establishes Task Force on Use of Surplus Public Lands for Housing.
- HB 3304 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Allows taxpayer to direct portion of income tax refund to purpose of providing housing to low income persons.

Public Hearing

- HB 3372
Requires coordinated care organization to provide initial health screening to foster child no later than 60 days after child enrolls in coordinated care organization or enters foster care system, whichever date is earlier.
- HB 3370
Defines "housing with services project" and requires project to register with Department of Human Services and meet certain requirements.
- HB 3253
Clarifies that state agencies and departments shall purchase certain products and services from Commission for the Blind.

Establishes Community Leverage Fund.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund for operation of Gatekeeper program by Northwest Senior and Disability Services agency.

- HB 3387 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on System Development Charges and specifies composition of task force membership.
- HB 3401
Prohibits local government from applying standards, conditions or procedures regulating development of needed housing on buildable land that have effect of reducing development density below maximum density level authorized in comprehensive plan designation.

Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services for Oregon Hunger Response Fund program services.
