- HB 2008
Requires landlord of manufactured dwelling park to pay tenant necessary relocation costs or applicable manufactured dwelling park closure penalty, as determined by Office of Manufactured Dwelling Park Community Relations, upon closure of park to convert to other use.
- HB 3331
Directs Office of Manufactured Dwelling Park Community Relations to establish and administer landlord-tenant dispute resolution program for disputes arising from notices of certain rent increases.
- HB 2996 **
Designates Act as Oregon First-Time Home Buyer Savings Account Act. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
- HB 3357 **
Increases amount of fees charged and collected by county clerks to record or file certain real property documents. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2930
Requires Department of Human Services and law enforcement agency to make efforts to determine military status of parents or guardians of child who is subject of report of child abuse.
- HB 2661
Requires long term care referral provider to be certified by Health Licensing Office.
- HB 3370
Defines "housing with services project" and requires project to register with Department of Human Services and meet certain requirements.
- HB 3372
Requires coordinated care organization to provide initial health screening to foster child no later than 60 days after child enrolls in coordinated care organization or enters foster care system, whichever date is earlier.
- HB 2852 **
Extends sunset for tax credit for affordable housing lenders. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
- HB 2534 **
Establishes Community Leverage Fund. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2007

Requires city or county to review and decide on applications for certain housing developments containing affordable housing units as first priority.

HB 3405 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Requires Department of Human Services to seek waiver of federal requirements in Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program in order to allow recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance to receive advance installment payments of tax credit for dependent care expenses.

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
