- HB 2170 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11 AGENDA Establishes Office of Oregon Ombudsmen, containing Long Term Care Ombudsman, Residential Facilities Ombudsman, Foster Parent Ombudsman, Foster Child Ombudsman and Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator.
- HB 2433 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11 AGENDA Directs Housing and Community Services Department to establish pilot program in which department constructs low-income senior housing development on school district land and school district rents to low-income seniors at reduced rent in exchange for classroom assistance.
- HB 2684 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes minimum hourly wage rate of \$15 per hour for employees who provide direct care to residents of residential training facility or residential training home.
- HB 3253
Clarifies that state agencies and departments shall purchase certain products and services from Commission for the Blind.
- HB 3273
Modifies requirements relating to evacuation of residents of adult foster homes.
- HB 3359
Creates Dementia Community Assistance Program in Department of Human Services to provide grants to community organizations providing assistance and training to individuals who care for persons with dementia who live at home.
- HB 3372
Requires coordinated care organization to provide initial health screening to foster child no later than 60 days after child enrolls in coordinated care organization or enters foster care system, whichever date is earlier.
- HB 2377 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Authorizes city or county to adopt ordinance or resolution granting exemption for newly rehabilitated or constructed multiunit rental housing.

HB 3063 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Mental Health Housing Fund, appropriates moneys to Oregon Health Authority and requires authority to seek out and apply for additional moneys for fund to pay for construction and start-up costs of housing for individuals with mental illness.
