Work Session

- SB 244 A
Establishes notification requirements of Department of Human Services regarding reported or suspected abuses, deficiencies, violations or failures of child-caring agency to comply with full compliance requirements and regarding reports of suspected or substantiated abuse of child in care.
- SB 310
Authorizes city or county to designate area within jurisdiction as vertical housing development zone.
- SB 948 A
Prohibits residential facility from employing, in publicly funded position, individual found to have committed type of abuse that is disqualifying under rules adopted by Department of Human Services.
- SB 1027 A
Prohibits Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority from seeking payment from amounts in ABLE account.

Public Hearing

- SB 59 B
Authorizes court to remove fiduciary, or modify powers or authority of fiduciary, on motion of Long Term Care Ombudsman.
- SB 101 B
Authorizes child abuse investigation on school premises if investigation involves interview of suspected victim or witnesses but not person suspected of committing abuse.
- SB 268 A
Requires Department of Human Services to make records regarding investigation of report of child abuse occurring at school or in educational setting that involves child with disability available to Disability Rights Oregon.
- SB 277 A
Increases notice period for termination of rental agreement and removal of manufactured dwelling or floating home.
- SB 819 A
Expands parameters of duties and responsibilities of Critical Incident Response Team assigned by Department of Human Services upon becoming aware of fatality of child that was result of abuse or neglect.
