HB 2601

Makes nonsubstantive and technical changes in Oregon law.

HB 2608

Modifies applicability of previous amendments to Oregon Uniform Trust Code.

HB 2610

Specifies methods by which persons may sign and transfer corporation's documents in electronic form.

HB 2619

Permits pawnbroker to notify pledgor by electronic mail or other electronic means that pledge is at risk of forfeiture
pledgor agrees in writing to notification method.
