HB 2218

Requires that information concerning sex offenders convicted of certain offenses be released on website maintained by Department of State Police.

HB 2360

Modifies reporting obligation for sex offenders by requiring report within 10 days following change of residence.

HB 2409

Permits city to issue citation for speeding using red light camera in conjunction with other technology that is capable of measuring speed.
