Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2141

Directs court to order suspension of person's driving privileges upon person's conviction for offense related to sexual solicitation.

HB 2142

Requires state agency that issues certain authorizations to persons to suspend authorization upon receipt of court order that person has been convicted of specified crimes relating to solicitation or prostitution.

HB 2740

Increases age of trafficked person from 15 to 18 for crime of trafficking in persons for use in commercial sex act.
