### Work Session

Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

HB 2622

Authorizes financial institution to refuse certain financial transactions when financial institution reasonably believes financial exploitation of vulnerable person may have occurred, may have been attempted or is being attempted.

HB 2623

Allows trustee of trust to make disbursements for trustee's compensation or compensation of person providing investment advisory or custodial services out of principal or income under certain circumstances.

### Public Hearing

HB 2776

Authorizes appointment of guardian for person with disability who is in need of guardianship.

HB 2630

Makes changes to Oregon guardianship laws to assure adequate safeguards for respondents and protected persons.

HB 2217

Creates Falk-Alfano Act.
