HB 2250

Modifies deadlines by which Department of Corrections must submit proposed and revised inmate release plans to State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision.

HB 2615

Reduces penalty of theft committed by returning stolen merchandise if value of merchandise is under \$1,000.

HB 2616

Requires court in juvenile delinquency proceeding to advise youth, and parent or guardian of youth, of youth's right to counsel.
