#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2561

Directs Public Defense Services Commission to adopt policies providing for compensation of appointed counsel at rate commensurate with compensation of equivalent position within office of district attorney.

HB 2621 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Specifies what constitutes notification to, and cooperation with, law enforcement officials.

HB 2698

Allows person with other convictions within previous 10 years to file motion to set aside conviction after three years from date of judgment if other convictions were part of same criminal episode as conviction that is subject of motion.
