Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2345 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Extends sunset on provision authorizing Department of Human Services to appear as party in juvenile court proceeding without appearance of Attorney General.
- HB 2776
Authorizes appointment of guardian for person with disability who is in need of guardianship.
- HB 3302
Directs Public Defense Services Commission to develop and maintain Parent-Child Representation Program statewide to provide legal representation in juvenile dependency proceedings based on workload model of contracting that provides for caseload limits.

Work Session

- HB 2630
Makes changes to Oregon guardianship laws to assure adequate safeguards for respondents and protected persons.
