Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2611

Subject to collective bargaining agreement or employment agreement, requires law enforcement unit that hires police or corrections officer originally hired by another law enforcement unit, upon written request of original employing law enforcement unit, to reimburse original employing law enforcement unit for certain expenses incurred by original employing law enforcement unit.

HB 2618

Increases certain fees collected by sheriffs.

HB 2846

Authorizes reserve officers sponsored by law enforcement unit to pay for training as police with cash and G.I. Bill education benefits.

Work Session

HB 2113

Adds secular organizations to list of persons and entities authorized to solemnize marriages.

HB 2355 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to develop method for recording data concerning officer-initiated pedestrian and traffic stops.
