Public Hearing

HB 2718

Requires youth to consult with legal counsel in person, by telephone or by video conference prior to custodial interview with peace officer, and before waiver of constitutional rights.

HB 3244

Prohibits peace officer from using deceit, trickery or artifice during interview of youth concerning act that, if committed by adult, would constitute crime.

HB 3242

Requires peace officer to electronically record interview with youth when investigating crime, or allegation that youth committed act that if committed by adult would constitute crime.
