### **Public Hearing and Work Session**

HB 2732

Provides that person who enters motor vehicle to remove child or animal in imminent danger of suffering harm is not subject to criminal or civil liability if person meets certain requirements.

#### **Public Hearing**

HB 2625

Provides that forfeiture petition may be filed for animal impounded pending outcome of animal crime even if specific animal is not named in charging instrument.

HB 2637

Creates crime of animal abuse in third degree.

HB 3177

Allows seizure, constructive possession and forfeiture of hens and chicks used in connection with cockfighting operation.

HB 3282

Removes psittacines not bred and maintained commercially from definition of "livestock" used for laws regarding offenses committed against animals, interference with livestock production, unlawful possession of iodine matrix and dogs chasing livestock.

HB 3283

Amends findings by Legislative Assembly regarding provision of care and treatment for impounded or seized animals.
