HB 2322

Renames position of State Medical Examiner to Chief Medical Examiner.

HB 2472 **

Directs State Medical Examiner to assume counties' responsibilities related to death investigations.

HB 2992

Requires school district board and public charter school governing body to adopt and implement policy that requires volunteers to undergo criminal records check.

HB 2355 **

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to develop method for recording data concerning officer-initiated pedestrian and traffic stops.

HB 2616

Requires court in juvenile delinquency proceeding to advise youth, and parent or guardian of youth, of youth's right to counsel.
