## **Public Hearing and Work Session**

HB 2593

Requires that sexually explicit material involving minor remain in control of law enforcement agency or court throughout criminal proceeding or juvenile delinquency proceeding, provided that material is made reasonably available to defendant.

HB 3061

Establishes Task Force on Anonymous Text Message Services.

HB 3077

Requires court, upon request of crime victim, to order that victim's electronic mail address and social media account identifying information not be given to defendant unless good cause is shown.

HB 3303

Requires hospital to have protocol to ensure that law enforcement agency is notified within seven days of collection of sexual assault forensic evidence kit and that kits are stored for no less than 60 days after collection.
