Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2238 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Reduces crime classification of unlawful possession of controlled substance in Schedule I. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both, except in specified circumstances.
- HB 3056
Prevents extinguishment of lien upon entry of judgment in action to recover unpaid planned community or condominium assessment.
- HB 3057
Exempts certain homeowners associations and associations of unit owners from establishing reserve accounts.
- HB 3059
Precludes right of recovery by transferor of special declarant rights to interest in condominium.
- HB 3392
Establishes state policies and judicial practices regarding blindness in individuals who are parents, prospective parents or caretakers of children in domestic relations cases and juvenile dependency proceedings.
