Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 5
Modifies laws related to student athlete agents.
- SB 15
Expands authority of Superintendent of State Police to appoint Department of Corrections employees as special state police officers to assist in all department transport functions and duties.
- SB 16
Prohibits Department of Corrections facilitated dialogue or responsibility letter bank program facilitator, advisory committee member or staff person from being compelled to testify or produce evidence concerning facilitated dialogue and responsibility letter bank program communications, except as provided by department rule.
- SB 82
Sets forth state policy specifying that sanctions and punishment for violation of rules regulating conduct of youth offenders and other persons placed in physical custody of Oregon Youth Authority may not include placing youth offender or others in custody of youth authority alone in locked room.
- SB 184
Authorizes Department of Corrections to establish program for selling inmate handicrafts.
