Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 34
Expands "move over law" to include any motor vehicle that is displaying warning or hazard lights or specific indications of distress.
- SB 489
Eliminates obsolete terms and procedures in statutes relating to court records.
- SB 769 A
Provides that person may not dispose of, or transfer to another person for disposal, material or media that display Social Security number unless person, before disposing of material or media, makes Social Security number unreadable or unrecoverable or ensures that person that ultimately disposes of media or material makes Social Security number unreadable or unrecoverable.
- SB 927
Provides that seller or lessor of law enforcement dog is not liable for product liability for harm caused by dog if law enforcement agency to which dog was sold or leased has begun or completed training dog using training program approved by law enforcement agency or accredited and recognized animal handling organization.

Note change: SB 76 A has been removed and SB 34 has been added.
