Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 241 A
Directs Department of Corrections to assign implementation of bill of rights of children of incarcerated parents to existing public body.
- SB 795 A
Requires medical assessment provider or law enforcement officer to contact victim advocate and make reasonable efforts to ensure that victim advocate is present and available at medical facility.

Work Session

- SB 34
Expands "move over law" to include any motor vehicle that is displaying warning or hazard lights or specific indications of distress.
