Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 261 A
Makes evidence about sexual behavior or predisposition inadmissible in civil proceeding except under certain circumstances.
- SB 497 A
Provides that person may file motion to set aside record of criminal citation or criminal charge in addition to record of arrest.
- SB 507
Clarifies crimes classification categories that may be expunged if requirements met.
- SB 931 A
Provides that court has discretion over selection of alternate jurors and when alternate jurors are informed of alternate status.
- SB 960 A
Modifies definition of "anonymous kit" in reference to testing of sexual assault forensic evidence kits.
