#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 357 A  
Modifies penalties for crime of interfering with public transportation.
- SB 961 A  
Allows defendant to file petition for driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement 14 days after receiving evidence under certain circumstances.

#### Work Session

- SB 117 A  
Places certain additional prohibitions and requirements on towers.
- SB 241 A  
Directs Department of Corrections to assign implementation of bill of rights of children of incarcerated parents to existing public body.
- SB 257 A  
Modifies crime of official misconduct in the first degree to include commission of official misconduct in the second degree when public servant is aware of and consciously disregards risk that violation places vulnerable person in danger of physical injury or of being victim of sex crime or causes withholding of necessities from vulnerable person.
- SB 327 A  
Provides recreational immunity to holder of any legal or equitable title of land.
- SB 488 A  
Requires law enforcement agency that recovers vehicle reported as stolen to share owner's contact information with tower that assumes control of vehicle.
- SB 751 A  
Prohibits form of marriage application, license or record from requiring address for entity authorized to solemnize marriage.
