SB 95 B

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/31/2017 AGENDA: Requires certain securities professionals to report suspected financial exploitation of vulnerable persons to Department of Consumer and Business Services.

SB 690 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/31/2017 AGENDA: Establishes procedures for petitioning for and issuing Certificate of Good Standing.

SB 714 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/31/2017 AGENDA: Allows court to include reasonable residency restrictions as special condition of probation for person convicted of stalking or violating court's stalking protective order.

SB 1055

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/31/2017 AGENDA: Expands definition of "deployment" or "deployed" to include "mobilization" of member of Armed Forces, National Guard or reserve component in specific laws affecting certain family law judgments.
