HB 2859

Creates or adjusts sunset dates for certain property tax expenditure provisions.

HJR 9

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow district that is surviving or successor district following merger of union high school district and common school district to maintain respective permanent limit of each taxing district before merger for purposes of imposing ad valorem property taxes.

HB 2407

With respect to deferred billing credits, provides that four percent interest be charged for period of dispute on additional taxes ordered upon final resolution of dispute.

HB 2779

Sets conditions under which person or agent collecting moneys for state agency may take more than one business day to transmit moneys to State Treasurer.
