Public Hearing

- HB 2037
Increases rate of taxation on cigarettes and tobacco products.
- HB 2056
Increases rates of taxation on cigarettes and tobacco products.
- HB 2062
Expands definition of tobacco products for purpose of taxation to include inhalant form nicotine.
- HB 2084 **
Directs Department of Revenue to establish and maintain list of persons that sell or accept orders for cigarettes, inhalant delivery systems or tobacco products that are to be transported from a point outside this state to consumer within this state and that either do not require age verification or fail to pay tax. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2119
Increases cigarette tax.
- HB 2662
Increases cigarette tax and provides for distribution of increase in revenue.
- HB 3178
Imposes tax on wholesale sale of inhalant-form nicotine based on percentage of wholesale price.
