Work Session

HJR 9

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow district that is surviving or successor district following merger of union high school district and common school district to maintain respective permanent limit of each taxing district before merger for purposes of imposing ad valorem property taxes.

HB 2859

Creates or adjusts sunset dates for certain property tax expenditure provisions.

HB 3180

Authorizes Department of Revenue and units of local government to disclose to each other information related to administration of transient lodging tax laws.

HB 2274

For purposes of corporate tax apportionment calculations, replaces sales factor with receipts factor.

HB 2400

Authorizes any state agency or department to enter into agreements with any political subdivision for collection, enforcement, administration and distribution of local transient lodging taxes of such political subdivision.
