HB 2087

Expands taxpayer bill of rights.

HB 2019

Requires Department of Revenue to submit to Legislative Revenue Officer information from Oregon tax returns about certain corporations doing business in Oregon.

HB 3453

(Carried Over from 2-23 Agenda) Requires, for purposes of property tax exemption, certain lease agreements for taxable property entered into by institution, organization or public body whose property is tax exempt to include express term that any tax savings resulting from such exemption shall inure solely to benefit of lessee institution, organization or public body.

HB 3260

(Carried Over from 2-23 Agenda) Authorizes coastal county to impose local transient lodging tax on residential short-term vacation rental property by submitting question to county electors.

HB 2047

(Carried Over from 2-23 Agenda) Exempts from taxation real property of nonprofit health clinic that is occupied or used to provide health services, or administrative services necessary to provide such health services, and is either federally qualified health center or occupied or used to serve specified low-income or needy patients.

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
