#### Public Hearing

- HB 2225  
Requires state agency to report to Director of Oregon Department of Administrative Services when any budgeted position is vacant for six months.
- HB 2332  
Extends suspension of requirement that state agencies attain 11-to-1 ratio of nonsupervisory employees to supervisory employees to 2017-2019 biennium.
- HB 2333  
Allows state agency that is unable to sell state real property or equitable interest in state real property, after following certain procedures for sale, to continuously offer real property or equitable interest for sale using any means state agency considers appropriate.
- HB 2946  
Expands definition of "state agency" for purposes of Oregon transparency website.

#### Work Session

- HB 2298  
Requires that all candidates who will appear on primary or general election ballot file statements of economic interest.
- HB 2577  
Requires lobbyist statements filed with Oregon Government Ethics Commission to identify each bill or measure introduced before Legislative Assembly lobbyist lobbied on, whether lobbyist lobbied in favor or in opposition to bill or measure, each legislative topic that was not bill or measure that lobbyist lobbied on, each person or entity that hired lobbyist and how much moneys person or entity paid lobbyist.
