#### Public Hearing

HB 3361

Directs State Chief Information Officer to appoint Chief Data Officer to maintain web portal for publication of data of state agencies.

HB 3399

Requires State Chief Information Officer by rule to require contracting agency that undertakes information technology initiative to provide in solicitation documents and public contract that contractor that supplies electronic database or structured collection of electronically stored data must supply contracting agency with capability to export data in nonproprietary open format and to redact from data information that contracting agency may not disclose.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2101

Sunsets certain exemptions from disclosure for public records.

HB 2332

Extends suspension of requirement that state agencies attain 11-to-1 ratio of nonsupervisory employees to supervisory employees to 2017-2019 biennium.

#### Work Session

HB 2333

Allows state agency that is unable to sell state real property or equitable interest in state real property, after following certain procedures for sale, to continuously offer real property or equitable interest for sale using any means state agency considers appropriate.
