- HB 2122 A  
Modifies requirements for coordinated care organizations.
- HB 2813  
Directs Department of Justice to conduct study relating to prosecution of crime of unlawful dissemination of an intimate image and submit report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2018.

#### Work Session

- HB 2015  
Directs Oregon Health Authority to reimburse doula at rate of no less than \$350 per pregnancy for services provided to medical assistance recipient.
- HB 2131 \*\*  
Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules applying certain oil spill prevention and emergency response planning requirements to railroads that own or operate high hazard train routes in this state. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2342  
Updates Insurance Code provisions applicable to health insurance in accordance with federal requirements.
- HB 2584 \*\*  
Lists specified types of expenditures that are definitively considered to be made in coordination with candidates for purposes of determining whether expenditure is considered independent expenditure. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
