HB 3418

Modifies methodology for reimbursement of health care services and supplies provided to enrollees in health benefit plans offered by Public Employees' Benefit Board.

HB 3440 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Specifies that Oregon Health Authority may use prescription monitoring information to determine whether practitioners are prescribing opioids or opiates in compliance with guidelines for prescribing opioids and opiates.

HB 3456

Permits establishment of photovoltaic solar power generation facility on certain high-value farmland.

Work Session

HB 2349

Prohibits printing or circulation of imitation voters' pamphlet unless pamphlet is clearly marked as unofficial.

HB 2428

Allows candidate one business day to pay fee for candidate space in voters' pamphlet if Secretary of State or county clerk determines that petition for candidate space did not contain required number of signatures of active electors.

HB 2873

Requires governing body of municipal corporation to publish notice of election involving local option tax measure or general obligation bond measure by filing with Secretary of State for publication on ORESTAR.

HB 2927

Enacts Interstate Compact for Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote.

HB 3203 A

Requires contracting agency to perform analysis to determine whether constructing public improvement with contracting agency's own equipment and personnel will result in least cost to contracting agency.

HJR 10

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to vest power of impeachment of statewide elected Executive Branch officials in House of Representatives and power to try impeachments in Senate.
