Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3463
Allows establishment of way of necessity when property has existing enforceable access to public road in certain circumstances.
- SB 225 A
Provides that treasurer of political committee or treasurer of petition committee is personally responsible for performance of specified duties.
- SB 229 A
Removes requirement that person elected to county office provide county clerk with certificate of election.
- SB 520 A
Requires that recall petition of district officer of irrigation district be filed with members of board of directors of irrigation district who are not subject to recall petition.

Work Session

- HB 2947
Directs specified state agencies to file annual report with interim committees of Legislative Assembly on general government affairs describing amount of federal funds received by agencies in preceding fiscal year and describing plan to operate agency if amount of federal funds received by agency in current fiscal year is reduced.
- HB 3464
Prohibits public body from disclosing specified information concerning person unless required by state or federal law.
