Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 43 A
Revises and clarifies circumstances in which individuals, including public officials and elected public officials, must register with Oregon Government Ethics Commission and file lobbyist registration statement.
- SB 44
Permits executive director of Oregon Government Ethics Commission to designate employee of commission to fulfill any duty or responsibility assigned to executive director by law or by commission.
- SB 333 B
Requires Oregon Business Development Department to consult with Department of Revenue in establishing and administering Oregon Industrial Site Readiness Program.

Work Session

- HB 3463
Allows establishment of way of necessity when property has existing enforceable access to public road in certain circumstances.
- SB 86
Authorizes Oregon Department of Administrative Services to require fingerprints of certain persons who are employed by or applying for employment with qualified entity or who provide services or seek to provide services to qualified entity.
- SB 208 B
Provides that school district may not deny participation in interscholastic activities by student who attends public charter school.
