Work Session

- SB 754 A
Creates offense of selling tobacco products or inhalant delivery systems to person under 21 years of age.
- SB 1025 A
Creates process by which certain persons who practice profession related to enforcing or providing for public health and safety and who, in performance of official duties, come into contact with blood, bodily fluid or other potentially infectious material of another person may petition court for order compelling testing of other person for communicable disease.
- SB 1036 B
Provides that certain activities are not considered surface mining and are exempt from surface mining permit requirements of State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.
- SCR 18
Designates osprey as official state bird.
