HB 2482

Removes hours of operation restriction on self-service at filling stations, service stations, garages and other dispensaries in low-population counties.

HB 2458

Allows nonretail facility located in low-population county to permit self-service retail sales of Class 1 flammable liquids.

HB 2462

Increases amount by which vehicle equipped with fully functional idle reduction system designed to reduce fuel use and emissions from engine idling may exceed maximum weight limitations.

HB 2292
