HB 2569

Requires vehicle dealer to disclose certain information concerning manufacturer recalls that apply to motor vehicle that customer intends to purchase or lease from vehicle dealer.

HB 2667 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on Vision Zero: Achieving Zero Traffic Crashes, Injuries and Fatalities.

HB 2568

Specifies, for purposes of exempting certain vehicles from overall allowable length of vehicles under Vehicle Code, that disruption in services provided by public utility, telecommunications utility, people's utility district or cooperative rural electrification district is emergency.

Work Session

HB 2495

Removes requirement that person intending to meet financial responsibility requirements for driving in this state by self-insuring have more than 25 vehicles, including commercial buses, registered in person's name.
