Authorizes certain intergovernmental entities created to operate, maintain, repair and modernize transportation facilities to impose property taxes in support of those purposes, or issue general obligation bonds supported by property tax revenues, if entity obtains approval of governing bodies of affected cities and counties in entity territory.
