#### Work Session

- HB 2745 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Authorizes certain intergovernmental entities created to operate, maintain, repair and modernize transportation facilities to impose property taxes in support of those purposes, or issue general obligation bonds supported by property tax revenues, if entity obtains approval of governing bodies of affected cities and counties in entity territory.
- HB 2910  
Requires snowmobiles and certain all-terrain vehicles to cross highway at intersection or more than 100 feet from intersection.
- HB 2482 A  
Limits self-service fuel dispensing to low-population counties of eastern Oregon and specified counties.

#### Public Hearing

- HB 2749 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Port of Hood River, in collaboration with Department of Transportation, to study feasibility of replacing Hood River-White Salmon Interstate Bridge.
- HB 2750  
Modifies laws related to interstate bridges operated by local governments.
- HB 2922  
Increases surcharge collected for issuance of Crater Lake National Park registration plates.
- HB 2596 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Specifies decreased vehicle registration fee for truck tractor used exclusively to tow travel trailer for personal use.
