Public Hearing

- HB 3125
Relating to transportation.
This bill will be replaced with a measure regarding autocycles.
- HB 3120
Provides that Department of Transportation must designate vehicle dealer as agent.
- HB 3231
Authorizes governing bodies of cities and counties to jointly form district for purposes of acquisition, design, construction, reconstruction, installation, operation, maintenance and repair of limited-access public highway projects within district boundaries.
- HB 2288 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds for Connect Oregon.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3118 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds to finance repair or replacement of Siuslaw River bulkhead.

Work Session

- HB 2463
Allows Department of Transportation and person, under certain circumstances, to enter into agreement that enables person to transact any function of department on behalf of department.
- HB 2749 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Port of Hood River, in collaboration with Department of Transportation, to study feasibility of replacing Hood River-White Salmon Interstate Bridge.
- HB 2750
Modifies laws related to interstate bridges operated by local governments.
- HB 2320 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs State Marine Board to create Nonmotorized Boating Program.
