Public Hearing

HB 3416
Directs Department of Transportation to offer extended weekday hours and Saturday operating schedules at field offices.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3230 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Transportation for deposit in Safe Routes to Schools Fund for grant awards under safe routes to schools program.

HB 3389
Expands criteria for traffic offenses related to rail crossings and adds requirement for drivers to stop for approaching on-track equipment.

HB 2682
Authorizes cities and counties, by process established by rule, to establish designated speed for certain highways without first seeking approval from Department of Transportation.

Work Session

HB 2750
Modifies laws related to interstate bridges operated by local governments.

HB 2290 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Adjusts certain fees imposed by Department of Transportation.

HB 2288 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds for Connect Oregon.

HB 2464 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Eliminates caps on number of subject vehicles eligible to participate in road usage charge program.

HB 3120
Provides that Department of Transportation must designate vehicle dealer as agent.

HB 3125
Requires Department of Transportation to study options for improving highway infrastructure in this state.
