HB 2100

Provides that portions of Interstate 5 and Interstate 205 shall be known as Oregon Medal of Honor Highway.

HB 2847 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to develop program under which department, pursuant to contract with financial institution, provides loan guarantees or credit guarantees for qualified veterans for purpose of refinancing existing purchase-money mortgages or similar mortgages of homes used primarily as principal residence by veterans.

HB 2887 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Allows credit against income taxes for employment of qualified military veterans.

HB 2908 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates position of Veteran Volunteer Coordinator in Department of Veterans' Affairs and specifies responsibilities.
