HB 3319 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes minimum amount that Legislative Assembly must appropriate to Department of Veterans' Affairs in each biennium, apart from appropriations from veterans' services fund established under Ballot Measure 96 (2016).

HB 2847 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11/2017 AGENDA: Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to develop program

under which department, pursuant to contract with financial institution, provides loan guarantees or credit guarantees

for qualified veterans for purpose of refinancing existing purchase-money mortgages or similar mortgages of homes

HB 2890

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/11/2017 AGENDA: Directs Oregon Military Department to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2018, regarding implementation of Oregon Code of Military Justice.

HB 2233

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs and county veterans' service officers to provide aid and assistance to Korean Vietnam War veterans to obtain health care coverage and services and, upon determination that veteran is not eligible for health care coverage and services under federal and state laws, to implement program to provide such coverage and services.

HB 2690 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Oregon Educational and Workforce Development Bridge Loan Program in Department of Veterans' Affairs to conduct outreach and provide loans to veterans and disabled veterans who are enrolled in approved course of study, approved professional training, approved workforce development program or approved apprenticeship in connection with institution of higher education, and who are eligible to receive federal educational aid or other financial assistance that is temporarily unavailable.

HB 2895 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for seismic needs assessments in 27 school districts in which seismic needs assessments have not been conducted.

HB 2908 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates position of Veteran Volunteer Coordinator in Department of Veterans' Affairs and specifies responsibilities.
