- SB 25 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Revises continuing education requirement for residential contractors.
- SB 35
Increases threshold amount that must be met before person is required to submit motor vehicle accident report.
- SB 37
Modifies laws related to driving privileges.
- SB 336
Allows construction contractor or business to temporarily continue operation after person ceases to be responsible managing individual for contractor or business.
- SB 417 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Transportation to establish State Parks registration plate program for issuance of special registration plate.
- SB 430
Requires insurer to pay claims up to coverage limits for insured's uninsured motorist coverage, less amounts recovered from other motor vehicle liability insurance policies.
- SB 431
Requires insurer to pay claims up to coverage limits for insured's uninsured motorist coverage, less amounts recovered from other motor vehicle liability insurance policies.
