- SB 94  
Increases threshold for estimated cost at which construction project sites must provide sanitary facilities by changing amount that triggers requirement from \$1 million to \$1.75 million.
- SB 96 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary  
Requires broker-dealers and state investment advisers to maintain errors and omissions insurance policy in amount of at least \$1 million as condition of state licensure, if broker-dealer or state investment adviser has discretionary trading authority or has custody of client funds.
- SB 97  
Provides that Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services must act as, or acknowledge another regulatory official as, group-wide supervisor for internationally active insurance group.
- SB 98  
Requires certain persons that service residential mortgage loans in this state to obtain or renew license.
- SB 256 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Willamette Falls Locks Commission as policy-making and advisory body for issues relating to repair, reopening, operation, maintenance and future transfer of ownership of navigational canal and locks.
- SB 601  
Increases threshold for estimated cost at which construction project sites must provide sanitary facilities by changing amount that triggers requirement from \$1 million to \$2 million.
