- SB 109 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Statewide Earthquake Insurance for Residential Property and specifies composition of task force membership.
- SB 328
 - Makes biomass facilities that registered with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System on or after January 1, 2011, eligible for renewable energy certificates.
- SB 334
 - Requires State Department of Energy to develop and maintain inventory of biogas and renewable natural gas resources available to this state.
- SB 339
