Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 838
- Excludes persons who are not developers of timeshares from compliance with certain provisions governing timeshares. SB 839
 - Requires certain trailers previously exempt from registration to be registered.
- SB 849 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue

Designates Act as Oregon First-Time Home Buyer Savings Account Act.

Work Session

- SB 109 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Statewide Earthquake Insurance for Residential Property and specifies composition of task force membership.
- SB 134

Subjects motor vehicle seller and buyer to certain conditions contingent on lender's agreement or failure to agree to purchase retail installment contract or lease agreement for motor vehicle.

SB 332

Permits insurer to offer certain rebates with aggregate value that does not exceed \$100 in calendar year to insureds other than persons for whom insurer issues health insurance or health benefit plan.

SB 344 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires snowmobiles and certain all-terrain vehicles to cross highway at intersection or more than 100 feet from intersection.

SB 645

Expands definition of "vehicle of special interest" to include Humvees.

Note Change: Public hearings and possible work session was removed for SB 417, and work sessions were added for SB 109 and SB 134.
