#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 417 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Transportation to establish State Parks registration plate program for issuance of special registration plate.
- SB 838  
Excludes persons who are not developers of timeshares from compliance with certain provisions governing timeshares.
- SB 839  
Requires certain trailers previously exempt from registration to be registered.
- SB 849 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue  
Designates Act as Oregon First-Time Home Buyer Savings Account Act.

#### Work Session

- SB 332  
Permits insurer to offer certain rebates with aggregate value that does not exceed \$100 in calendar year to insureds other than persons for whom insurer issues health insurance or health benefit plan.
- SB 344 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires snowmobiles and certain all-terrain vehicles to cross highway at intersection or more than 100 feet from intersection.
- SB 645  
Expands definition of "vehicle of special interest" to include Humvees.
