#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2510 A  
Authorizes commercial tenant to install on premises and use electric vehicle charging station.
- HB 2511 A  
Authorizes residential tenant to install on premises and use electric vehicle charging station for personal, noncommercial use.
- HB 2624  
Exempts out-of-state banks, extranational institutions and foreign associations from requirement to file notice before dealing in notes secured by mortgages or trust deeds, if authorized to conduct banking business in this state by certificate of Department of Consumer and Business Services.
- HB 3101 A  
Prohibits hotels or inns from charging facility fees in addition to price of guest room rental unless facility fees are disclosed prior to guest room reservation or rental.
- HB 3139 A  
Requires Director of Oregon Business Development Department to adopt rules that ensure Arts Program considers regional differences in public access to, or opportunities for engagement in, arts and cultural development when determining eligibility for grant awards and that promote investment in communities where opportunities for engagement in arts and cultural development are limited.
- HB 3184 A  
Permits Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to develop and implement system that provides loan counseling to consumers who borrow from payday loan lenders and title loan lenders.
